To be displayed as prominently as possible at the church building for fourteen days, posted publicly on website or social media, and by email or letter and/or by phone so as to ensure that all members of the congregation receive intimation in some form or other

At a meeting held on Zoom on 27 July 2020, the Nominating Committee chose the person who they wish to propose to this congregation of Udney & Pitmedden Church to be our new minister. The name of the person proposed is **Rev Gert Janse van Rensburg**.

Arrangements have been made for Rev Gert Janse van Rensburg, to conduct public worship in Pitmedden Church on **Sunday the 13th day of September 2020 at 10am**.

The Presbytery of Gordon have approved that:

- Only a small representative number of members of the congregation who will be specifically invited shall be present when Rev Gert Janse van Rensburg conducts public worship.

UDNY & PITMEDDEN VACANCY PROTOCOL

Immediately after that service, a vote on whether or not Rev Gert Janse van Rensburg should be appointed as the new minister of this congregation of Udney & Pitmedden will be opened. Anyone whose name appears on the Electoral Register of this congregation of Udney & Pitmedden shall be entitled to vote. No one else shall be entitled to vote.

Those who are entitled to a vote, and for whom the Kirk Session hold contact details shall receive a letter with details on how to cast their vote.

Along with that letter, there will be included a specially numbered stamped addressed envelope and a paper ballot with their unique number printed on it.

Every vote returned must have a unique number written on it. Votes returned without a unique number will not be counted. The unique numbers will not be linked to how votes are cast. All votes must be cast or returned by post not later than Saturday the 19th day of September at 6 o'clock pm.
