

Dear Friends

At last, good news! Pitmedden Church is to reopen this Sunday, 6 September at 10am.

We would like to welcome you back to God's house for worship. It will be a different experience from the usual service due to current restrictions but we hope that you will be able to find peace to worship and to pray. Unfortunately no singing is allowed.

Several restrictions are also necessary.

Due to physical distancing, only **25** people can attend the service and this will be on a 'first come, first served' basis. We are sorry if you will not be able to attend the service due to this limitation.

In addition, the following notes are provided for your guidance when you come to church.

Symptoms:

If you display any of these symptoms please do not come to church and remain at home:

Persistent coughing; High temperature; loss of taste or smell

Face coverings:

You will be required to wear a face mask when in church (unless you cannot do so for medical reasons). There will be face masks available should you require one.

Contact Details:

We will ask you for your name and contact details to support NHS Scotland's Test and Protect System

Movement:

We will ask you to sit in a particular seat and move in a one way system around the building

Hand Hygiene:

Please use hand sanitiser when entering or leaving the building

Physical Distancing:

Please maintain 2 metres distance from others and avoid contact with people outside your own household.

Toilets:

Please note that only the disabled toilet will be open

We are sorry about all the regulations but we are complying with Government and Church of Scotland guidelines.

At least we can come together to worship God in word and prayer and to find fellowship with our church family here.
